How to form a Film Society

- 1. Those who are desirous of forming film society may adopt a resolution to this effect in a meeting attended by not less than seven persons who will be called the promoters.
- 2. The society should have Rules and Regulations (Byelaws) approved in the meeting.
- 3. Then apply to the District Registrar for Registration under Charitable Societies Act.
- 4. After registration elect office bearers and committee as stipulated in the byelaws.
- 5. Then apply to Federation of Film Societies of India for affiliation in prescribed form.
- 6. The membership strength of a society should ordinarily be not less than hundred. However the Regional Council of FFSI may at its discretion waive this requirement in specific cases.
- 7. When the affiliation is approved, the society should pay the affiliation fee of Rs. 500/-
- 8. Every society shall pay Annual Subscription of Rs. 4 per member subject to a minimum of Rs. 500/- by 30th April each year.
- 9. For Film Clubs formed in educational Institutions affiliation will be given on the recommendation of the head of Institution. Such a film club does not require registration under Charitable Societies Act.
